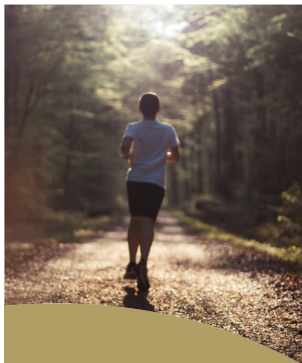
Maintain good hygiene, eg washing hands as often as possible

STAGE 1 PREPARE

- Personal fitness and skills
- Outside activities with other household members only
- Online training with England Touch



CURRENT STAGE

STAGE 2 TRAIN

- Small group working
- Maintain social distance
- Multiple groups at venues
- No mixing groups (same group sticks together)
- Fitness / skills, no contact
- Minimal equipment sharing
- Online training with England Touch



STAGE 3 PLAY

- Full contact training, including games
- Larger groups in training
- Limited group travel between towns/areas
- Online training with England Touch
- Delivery of courses at your club



STAGE 4 LOCAL

- Playing in your local area/region
- 1. Fixtures between 2 teams, then
- 2. Local tournaments up to 4 teams



STAGE 5 REGIONAL

- Regional tournaments up to 8 clubs
- Provision of Regional Development Series
- In-person coaching/referee courses at regional locations



STAGE 6 NATIONAL

- Full national travel
- National Touch Series tournaments
- High Performance squad training
- In-person coaching/referee courses nationwide
