The England Touch Physiotherapist/sports therapist provides medical services: encompassing assessment, treatment and management of all players associated with England Touch Association in partnership with The Head of Medical Services.

Principles and Responsibilities

Include (but are not limited to) the following:

- To provide all aspects of injury and trauma management
- To liaise with all members of the medical team in treating and monitoring players injuries
- Report to Head of Medical Services on all matters arising with players injuries and progress
- Attend a minimum of 1 tournament and provide pitch side cover, first aid, assessment and management of injuries
- Hold a current qualification in emergency medical procedures including acute pitch-side care (management of spinal injuries, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, wounds etc)
- Maintain up to date records of assessment, treatment and plan of all players involved in care
- Return records, injury reports and critical incidents to the Head of Medical Services within 24 hours of the completion of the tournament.

Performance measures

- Develop and maintain effective communication skills with Head of Medical Services, tournament organiser and the medical staff
- Provide accurate documentation of injuries, treatment and rehab progress.
- Provide end of match report and end of tournament report to the Head of Medical Services.
