

Title: Head of Elite Performance

Role purpose:

- Lead the tactical and performance delivery of the High Performance Programme.
- Work with the HPD to design the necessary coaching and technical input needed to achieve the England Touch HP goals.
- Lead the HP coaching and playing team, ensuring that the input and contributions of coaches and players are maximised and aligned to the agreed direction.

Ensure the on-going successful development and delivery of England Touch elite High Performance programme.

Experience: Experience of Elite Touch Performance and or Coaching with a sound understanding of the current trends in the sport on the worldwide stage are essential. A knowledge of leading trends in coaching, including coaching science, sports science and the appropriate application of technology to assist performance is desirable.

Qualifications:

- Advanced Coaching (Level 2) qualification or above (Essential)
- Current Driving licence (Desirable)

Hours required: 10 or more hours per week.

Key dates: The touch calendar is cyclical, with key tournaments taking place over spring and summer with more of a focus on strategic planning and organisation over autumn and winter.

Line Management: The Head of Elite Performance directly manages the HP Coaching teams and oversees National/Elite coaches through these roles (see organagram).

Locations: Work from home; working away from home for both England training and tournament.

Contract type: 1 year term. Re-appointed yearly at the AGM. (Feb 2017.)
