

### **England National Squad – Head Coach**

ISSUE 5<sup>th</sup> August 2017

### Job purpose:

An England National Squad Head Coach will:

- Build their Management Team consisting of, but not limited to, an Assistance Coach and Team Manager for their England Squad; and
- Select, train and lead their squad of players for the 2018/2019 season.

**Experience:** coaching elite Touch teams at the international or England Nationals level (or equivalent).

**Qualifications:** a FIT Advanced Coaching (Level 2) qualification is compulsory for Opens Head Coaches, with a FIT Intermediate Coaching (Level 1) qualification being the minimum on appointment for all Junior. Senior and Masters Head Coaches; however, it will be mandatory for all Head Coaches to get the FIT Advanced Coaching (Level 2) qualification in 2018.

**Hours required:** 2-10 hours of planning and review work on a week-to-week basis (the workload varies throughout the campaign) in addition to attendance at individual squad training sessions and England High Performance Camps as well as delivering additional coaching clinics with other teams/groups as required.

### Key dates:

- England Touch Nationals (August Bank Holiday Weekend, 2017)
- England Touch ACE Weekend (18-19 November 2017)
- NTLs (December 2017, Australia) optional tournament
- England HP Training Camp (dates tbc but circa April 2018)
- European Touch Championships 2018 (18 to 22 July 2018, England)
- Touch World Cup 2019 (28 April to 5 May 2019, Malaysia)
- Friendly tournaments or tours with other National Touch Association teams to be confirmed separately by each national squad Head Coach.

**Reports to:** CEO until a High Performance Director is appointed.

Team: High Performance Team

Locations: Work from home; working away from home for both England training and tournaments.

Contract type: Appointment for 2018-2019

**Salary:** Voluntary role, expenses paid if applicable. Subsidised apparel provided. Subsidised training kit and equipment also provided. Budget for 2018/19 campaigns tbc.
