

Team Physiotherapist

Job Purpose

The England Touch Physiotherapist provides physiotherapy services: encompassing assessment, treatment and management of all players associated with England Touch Association in partnership with The Head of Medical Services, Lead Physiotherapist and all other members of the medical staff.

Responsibilities

Include (but are not limited to) the following:

1. Pre-tournament you will be required to work alongside the medical team to advise on preparation of players for international tournaments.
2. To provide all aspects of physiotherapy care by supporting players to provide pre-game treatment, massage and taping.
3. The job demands high levels of concentration being active throughout the tournament, performing assessments and treatment on and off the pitch. You will need to be confident in making quick clinical decisions to verify players are safe to continue playing, or if they need further intervention.
4. To liaise with all members of the medical team in treating and monitoring players injuries
5. Report to Head of Medical Services and Lead Physiotherapist on all matters arising with players injuries and progress
6. Be trained and up to date with emergency medical procedures and acute pitch side care (including spinal injuries and cardiopulmonary resuscitation as a qualified physiotherapist)

Skills Required

To be considered for this role you would ideally have:

- BSc (Hons) degree in physiotherapy and a member of the CSP
- 3 years qualified with the majority of time spent in MSK
- Pitch-side support experience/with pitch-side or medical qualification
- Advanced knowledge of strapping techniques and first aid
