

Head of Medical Team

Job Purpose

To lead the medical team at international events and to be an aid to players in the lead up to international tournaments, reporting into the High Performance Manager.

Responsibilities

Include (but are not limited to) the following:

1. Pre-tournament you will be required to work alongside coaches to advise on preparation of players for international tournaments.
2. The job involves leading a team of medical professionals and supporting players by providing pre- game treatment, massage and taping.
3. The job demands high levels of concentration being active throughout the tournament, performing assessments and treatment on and off the pitch. You will need to be confident in making quick clinical decisions to verify players are safe to continue playing, or if they need further intervention.
4. You will also be required to work with the England Touch Tour Manager and High Performance Manager to order supplies required for each tournament, as well as assist in the recruitment and interviewing of the rest of the medical team.

Skills Required

To be considered for this role you would ideally have:

- BSc (Hons) degree in physiotherapy
- Experience working with sports injuries on a day-to-day basis
- Pitch-side support experience
- Advanced knowledge of strapping techniques and first aid
