The day will start with registration from 9:00am.

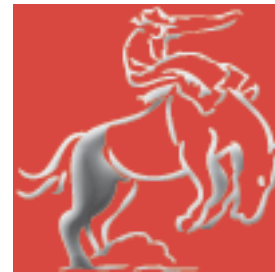

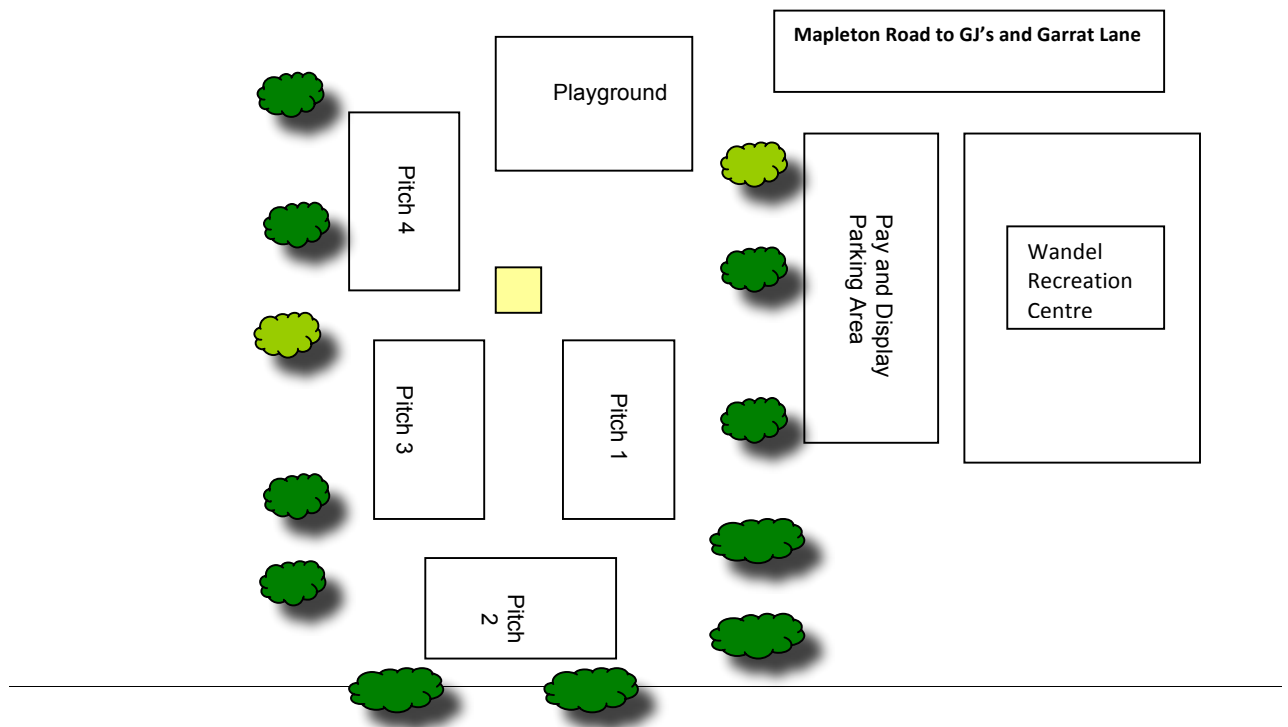
Sainsbury's and Waitrose supermarkets are both located within a 3 minute walk of the fields should you need to purchase any additional food or drinks during the day.

TRANSPORT DIRECTIONS

The venue is located off Garrat Lane on Mapleton Road, Wandsworth, SW18 4DN.

It is a 15 minute walk from both East Putney Tube Station and Wandsworth Town Mainline Stations.

The 220 and 28 buses stop right outside the fields in Mapleton Road.



PARKING

There is paid undercover parking available in the nearby Southside Shopping Centre just off Mapleton Road and there is also Pay and Display parking available next to the fields as illustrated in the above diagram.

Limited FREE PARKING is also available on the residential streets on the left hand side of the above map in Brathway Road and Longstaff Crescent which can be accessed from Merton Road rather than from Garrat Lane.

PROVIDED FOOD AND DRINK

Each team will receive a case of water and each player will receive a lunch pack for the day.
