

5 TOURNAMENT RULES and ADMIN

5.1 REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

Mini Nationals- Each team must register all their players by **6pm on Monday 16th September**, on the provided 'player flagging' document. This will enable us to print each team sheet to assist in your disclaimer signing in the morning. Teams are to pay their entrance fees at the captain's briefing.

<u>Open Trials</u> – Ensure that you have registered online, prior to arriving. Payment of £5 per player to be paid at registration. Use think link to register online:

5.2 RULES

Standard FIT rules apply.

5.3 MVP

These will be handed out during team registration. It is the team's responsibility to return these to tournament control post game.

5.4 Points

Points in the Pool stages should be allocated as follows:

- 3 Points Match Winner
- 1 Point Match Loser
- 2 Points Drawn Match
- 0 Points Forfeited Match, allocated to team responsible for the forfeit. The team not responsible for the forfeit will be awarded 3 points and a 5 0 winning score.

Determining Pool Table Standings Position in the pool competition table shall be determined by competition points as set out above. If at the conclusion of the pool stage two Teams are equal on competition points for any position in the pool, such position in the pool competition table will be determined by:

- a) The scoring points difference
- b) The result of the match between the two equal sides
- c) The highest scoring side.
- d) A coin toss between the two sides.

The Group winners and the second placed teams will progress to the Cup and Plate Competition. The third and fourth placed teams will progress to the Bowl and Shield Competition.
